

## GARDEN ACTIVITY

## Spring Seedling Pots

## SUPPLIES

- Empty toilet paper roll
- Crayons, colored pencils
- Paper tape or glue
- Scissors
- Potting soil mix
- Your favorite seeds

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Flatten a toilet paper roll (do not cut) and decorate it!
- 2. Fold the roll in half one way and then the other. Make sure the creases line up so it is in the shape of a square.
- 3. Make 4 cuts in each corner of the square roll. Fold the tabs over so they overlap (just like a box). Use paper tape to close it.
- 4. Pack potting soil into the pot until it is 3/4 full.
- 5. Moisten the soil and firmly press a sunflower seed into the pot. Be sure the seed is covered with a 1/4 inch layer of soil.
- 6. Place the pots on a sunny window sill and wait for your seedling to sprout. Keep the soil damp.
- 7. When your seedling is approximately 4-6 inches tall, find a spot to plant it outside. The pot will biodegrade in the soil if you keep it really wet.
